Describe how you feel about the Indian Removal Act, including some of the following talking points:

1. How does the Act affect you?
2. How do you stand to gain or lose from this act?
3. What are some of your personal hardships that you have to face?
4. What is our outlook on how this is going to work out?
5. Are you for or against the Indian Removal Act?

Length: Your journal entry must be at least 6 paragraphs. Each paragraph must be 5-6 sentences.
